# Austria outdoor power supply is OK



## Overview

---

Power in Austria is 220-230V AC, 50Hz. Basic appliances rated at 110V would be damaged by this and require a voltage converter for use. There is also a fire risk. This threat can apply also to power boards. Check that high-end electronic devices have inbuilt converters that cover the necessary ratings. Does Austria have a power adapter?

Their standard voltage is 230 V with a frequency of 50 Hz. Most outlets tend to be recessed into the wall with two pins. If you live in the United States, your type A or B plugs will not work in Austria. What kind of power adapter do I need for Austria?

Do I need a universal adapter for Austria?

We recommend getting a universal adapter so that you can use it on your trip to Austria as well as over 100 other countries. This particular adapter will allow you to charge three devices simultaneously and has a built-in fuse protector to keep your electronics safe from any unexpected power surges.

What voltage does Austria use?

Also, the voltage in Austria is the same as in Europe. What Outlet does Austria Use?

Type C plug sockets are used in Europe, Africa and Asia. They have two round pins and no grounding pin. These plugs are typically used with devices that have a voltage of 220-240V. This outlet is rated for 2.5 amps.

What does a travel plug adapter look like in Austria?

When you are going on a trip to Austria, be sure to pack the appropriate travel plug adapter that fits the local sockets. But what do those electrical outlets look like?

In Austria, types C and F are the official standards. Like almost all Continental European countries, Austria has standardized on the German plug and socket system.

How does the energy Intervention Powers Act work in Austria?
