

Base station communication equipment declaration



Overview

It is an equipment authorization issued by an FCC-recognized Telecommunication Certification Body (TCB) based on an evaluation of the supporting documentation and test data submitted by the responsible party (e.g., the manufacturer or importer) to the TCB. What are the approval procedures for equipment authorization?

The Commission has two different approval procedures for equipment authorization - Certification and Supplier's Declaration of Conformity (SDoC). The required procedure depends on the type of equipment being authorized as specified in the applicable rule part.

Is equipment authorized under the sdoc procedure listed in a commission database?

Equipment authorized under the SDoC procedure is not listed in a Commission database. However, the responsible party or any other party marketing the equipment must provide a test report and other information demonstrating compliance with the rules upon request by the Commission.

Who is not required to file an equipment authorization application?

The responsible party, who must be located in the United States, is not required to file an equipment authorization application with the Commission or a TCB. Equipment authorized under the SDoC procedure is not listed in a Commission database.

What is a telecommunication Certification Body (TCB) application?

The responsible party files with a Telecommunication Certification Body (TCB) an application for a grant of certification. An application for equipment authorization requires submission of information about the product, as listed in Section 2.1033.

Are digital voice systems and equipment compliant with P25 standards?

To improve interoperability across investments, grantees are strongly encouraged to ensure that digital voice systems and equipment purchased with federal grant funds are compliant with the P25 suite of standards, unless otherwise noted in a program's grant guidance.

What is a broadcast auxiliary microwave station?

See 47 CFR Part 74. Available to licensees of broadcast stations and to broadcast and cable network entities, broadcast auxiliary microwave stations are used for relaying broadcast television signals from the studio to the transmitter, or between two points such as a main studio and an auxiliary studio.
