China's 5G communication base station inverter grid-connected market



Overview

How many 5G base stations will China build in 2025?

China plans to construct over 4.5 million 5G base stations in 2025 while introducing additional policy and financial incentives to support industries expected to shape the next decade, the country's Ministry of Industry and Information Technology (MIIT) announced during its annual work conference.

How many 5G sites are there in China?

Mobile operators in China are ramping up 5G and 5G-A rollouts, with the former now at 4.5 million cell sites and the latter in 300 cities; a new 2027 roadmap will see 75% of mobile data in the country on 5G networks. 5G on 5M sites – China has over 4.486 million 5G sites; 5G now comprises more than 35% of total mobile base stations.

Why do Chinese communication companies rely on a power grid?

This is primarily due to the reliance of these base stations on the power grid, which derives over 70% of its energy from coal. 19,20 Compounded by the Chinese government's stringent low-carbon policies, which mandate environmental responsibility across all industries, 21 communication companies face considerable policy pressure.

Can China's communications industry reduce reliance on grid-powered systems?

While focused on China, the model and findings can serve as a blueprint for countries worldwide facing similar energy and infrastructure challenges in the age of digital expansion. It is important for China's communications industry to reduce its reliance on grid-powered systems to lower base station energy costs and meet national carbon targets.

Will 5G Revolution & 6G innovation be a priority next year?

The move comes as the country charted its vision for industrial growth during

a two-day work conference of the Ministry of Industry and Information Technology. With 4.19 million 5G base stations already in operation, the industry regulator said that "promoting 5G revolution and 6G innovation will be one of the priorities" next year.

Does China have a 5G network?

Wen Ku, director-general of the China Communications Standards Association, highlighted the nation's progress in telecommunications, stating, "China has made remarkable strides in 5G infrastructure, which gives it an unparalleled edge in exploring 6G technologies."
