Construction of new energy storage battery project in Azerbaijan



Overview

In May 2024, Nur Bukhara Solar PV LLC FE, a project company owned by Masdar, set out to build a 63 MW battery energy storage system alongside a 250 MW solar plant in the Alat district of the Bukhara region, billed as Uzbekistan's first big BESS project.

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Construction is underway on some of Central Asia's largest battery energy storage projects, while financing has been secured for what is described as the region's first integrated wind and storage facility. State-owned electricity generation and transmission company AzerEnergy is building a 250.

"AzerEnerji" is establishing battery storage systems (BESS) with a total capacity of 250 megawatts and an energy storage capacity of 500 megawatt-hours on the territory of the 500-kilovolt "Absheron" substation near the capital and the 220-kilovolt "Aghdash" substation located in the central part.

The 500-kilovolt "Absheron" and the 220-kilovolt "Aghdash" substations in Azerbaijan will reportedly have a capacity of 250 megawatts and a storage volume of 500 megawatt-hours / Courtesy Azerbaijan has ushered in a new era in its energy sector with the launch of large-scale Battery Energy Storage.
