Djibouti Outdoor Power Supply Monopoly



Overview

Does Djibouti have a high electricity price?

Despite this reduction, Djibouti remains among one-third of African countries that have the highest electricity prices. Despite strong social pressure to further reduce the price of electricity, the country cannot afford to sustainably subsidize the electricity supply.

Is Djibouti Telecom a monopoly?

To date, Djibouti Telecom holds a monopoly on all telecom services, including fixed lines, mobile, internet, and broadband in Djibouti. The absence of competition for such services has meant that the market has not reached its full potential.

Does Djibouti have a power grid?

With regard to electricity, connection to the grid remains a critical problem for Djibouti's economy. As a result of the interconnection between Djibouti and Ethiopia, the output of the Djibouti Electric Power Utility (EDD) rose by 13.6% in 2013. However, the increase in electric power generation is only partly passed on to the population.

Does Djibouti need development partners?

While several partners are present in the energy sector, Djibouti's requirements in this sector remain so great that only a concerted effort and even greater need for investment by the development partners are required to improve the situation in this sector, which is of critical importance for the country's economy.
