More distributed solar power in Ukraine is urgently needed to secure electricity in Ukraine, according to the IEA. [1] During the 2022 Russian invasion of Ukraine, the Merefafa solar energy plant in the Kharkiv region was destroyed by Russia; [2] damage was also reported at the Tokmak solar energy.

Ukraine's National Renewable Energy Action Plan, adopted in August 2024, sets renewable energy targets of 27% of electricity consumption and 25% of generation (2022: 14.3%), to be achieved by 2030. To achieve this, the plan foresees a total installed capacity of 12.2 GW of solar energy (5GW of.

Even as relentless attacks threaten its energy infrastructure, Ukraine is demonstrating remarkable resilience by significantly increasing its solar power capacity. In a powerful act of defiance and forward-thinking, the country has seen a massive surge in solar adoption, largely driven by citizens.
