# Gambia Telecommunication Base Station Inverter Grid Connection Construction Regulations



## Overview

---

What is the Internet tax in the Gambia?

The government imposes a 40 percent tax on telecommunications companies in The Gambia. The main Internet service providers are Gamtel, Africell, Netpage, and QCELL. Internet connectivity into The Gambia is managed by Gamtel, with bandwidth sold to other ISPs. Currently, none of the network operators are providing 5G services.

What are the challenges of Internet access in the Gambia?

Gambians face immense challenges with internet access due to expensive data. According to the Freedom House and the World Bank, high cost remains a primary hindrance to internet access in The Gambia, where 48.6 percent of individuals live in poverty.

Why is the Gambia not focusing on rural areas?

Service providers in the Gambia have not prioritized investments in network coverage in rural areas. Gambians face immense challenges with internet access due to expensive data.

What is the telecom market composition in Gambia?

Gambia's telecom market is dominated by the state-owned Gamtel, which retains a monopoly on fixed-line telephony services. Four mobile networks provide effective competition. The market's leader is Africell (owned by American), with about 65% market share.

How much does Internet cost in the Gambia?

According to the Freedom House and World Bank data, high cost is a primary hindrance to internet access in The Gambia, where 48.6 percent of individuals live in poverty. Data can cost up to \$100 per month for a high-speed internet connection. This is prohibitively expensive for most of the population.
