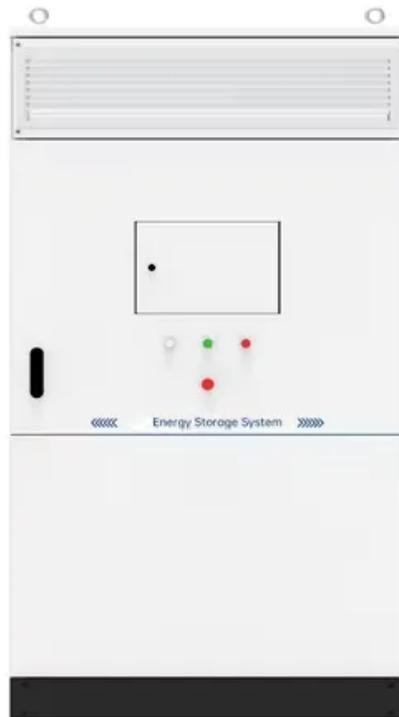

Georgia 5G base station electricity price per kilowatt- hour



Overview

How much does electricity cost in Georgia?

That adds up to \$2,856 per year. That's 5% lower than the national average electric bill of \$3,005. The average electric rates in Georgia cost 15 ¢/kilowatt-hour (kWh), so that means that the average electricity customer in Georgia is using 1,564.00 kWh of electricity per month, and 18768 kWh over the course of the year.

What is the average electricity rate in Georgia in 2025?

The average residential electricity rate in Georgia in 2025 is 14.42 cents per kilowatt hour, which is 13.82% below the national average rate of 16.73 cents. The electricity market in the state is regulated, meaning consumers must choose their electricity provider based on their location.

Where is Georgia Power located?

Georgia Power is an electric utility headquartered in Atlanta, Georgia, United States. Enter your zip code to see Georgia Power plans available in your area. Find Georgia Power GA September 2025 electricity plans and rates. SUMMER - June through September is Month-To-Month plan with average rate 5.6874¢ per kWh.

What is a monthly electric bill in Georgia?

Monthly electric bills are a product of how much electricity you use per month and your electric rate. In Georgia, the average monthly electric bill for residential customers is \$238/month, which is calculated by multiplying the average monthly consumption by the average electric rate: 1,564.00 kWh * 15 ¢/kWh.

Does Georgia Power offer a bill calculator?

A bill calculator has been prepared for customers of the Georgia Power Company. This bill calculator applies only to residential customers who are

When are Georgia Residential electric rates highest?

Georgia residential electric rates are highest in August and the highest average bill is in July. Monthly We report production data as it is published. Due to reporting methods and timing, data from 2023 and 2022 may be incomplete. Data is released in full each fall for the previous calendar year.
