Mali uses Type C/E electrical outlets with standard voltage of 220V and 50Hz frequency. If your device plugs don't match Mali's standards, we recommend purchasing suitable travel adapters in advance to ensure proper use. What power plug types are used in Mali?

Type C plugs consist of two round pins.

The standard voltage is 220 V and the standard frequency is 50 Hz. In Mali, power sockets conform to the types C and E standards. Type C sockets have two round pins, while type E sockets have two round pins and a hole for grounding. Both types are commonly found in the country. The voltage in Mali.
