A typical American household needs a 10-kilowatt (kW) system to adequately power their home, which costs \$28,241 in 2025. How much do solar panels cost on average?

As of 2025, the average cost of residential solar panels in the U.S. is between \$15,000 and \$25,000 before incentives. This typically translates to about \$2.50 to \$3.50 per watt of installed capacity (more on price per watt below). The total price depends.

The average cost of installing a 7.6kW solar system on your roof is \$23,100 before any incentives or tax credits, and most homeowners pay somewhere between \$19,100 and \$23,800. Prices vary widely based on factors like the

size of the system you need, the quality of the equipment you choose, how you.

How much do solar panels cost?

The price of solar panels changes depending on where you live, but the average for installation is just under \$29,000 or \$2.75 per watt. On the high end, we talked to a solar customer in Hawaii who spent \$100,000 going solar. Dion in Nevada said their 10-kW system cost about \$20,000, which is about the national average price for a 7-kW system.

How much does a home solar system cost?

In 2025, we surveyed 1,000 home solar customers across the U.S. to understand their experience shopping for and installing solar panel systems. Most homeowners said they paid around \$16,129 for a solar panel system, with an average of 14 solar panels installed.

How much does a solar system cost per watt?

As of publishing, the average cost per watt is \$2.84. Most solar companies set the price according to the solar system's wattage. A solar installation's "cost per watt" is a little like the "price per square foot" when you buy a house. It helps compare the value of solar energy systems in different sizes.

How much do solar panels cost in 2025?

In 2025, average solar panel costs continue to decrease due to advancements in technology and economies of scale. Prices vary by system type, size, and installation needs. Residential solar panels typically cost between \$12,500 and \$17,500 for a 5-kilowatt system.

How much does solar cost in California?

Divide annual kWh by ~1,200 (typical kWh/year per kW of solar in much of California). In California, expect \$2.75 - \$3.50 per watt before incentives (solar panel cost in California). This gives your solar cost per square foot. Estimate your system size, price before and after incentives, and cost per square foot.
