Overview

According to a report published by the Ministry of Energy (EM) on January 23, 2025, Hungary surpassed Greece in 2024 to become the leader in photovoltaic power generation in Europe, with photovoltaic systems accounting for 25% of the country's electricity production, ahead of Greece's 22% and Spain's 21%. Does Hungary have solar energy?

Alongside the Netherlands, Hungary is also one of the few countries where solar energy covered more than 80% of electricity demand on over 70 days during peak generation periods in 2023. By spring 2025, Hungary had built around 7,800 megawatts of solar energy capacity, with four-fifths of that installed since 2020.

How many solar power plants are in Hungary?

Hungary has deployed almost 8 GW of solar capacity, according to the country's deputy minister of energy, Gábor Czepek. In a social media post, Czepek said that more than 300,000 solar power plants are operating across the nation, with over four-fifths of the existing capacity installed since 2020.

Will Hungary build a solar factory in Northern Hungary?

There are plans to open a factory dedicated to building solar panels in Northern Hungary, representing an investment of 18.9 billion forints (nearly 6,000,000 USD). This new rapid growth can be attributed to Hungary choosing to follow in the footsteps of the European Union, which hopes to have 30+ percent renewable energy by 2030.

Can photovoltaics be used in Hungary?

Hungary has experienced a remarkable boom in solar energy in recent years. It has been shown in both the private and industrial sectors how strong the potential of photovoltaics actually is in this country.

Is Hungary a good country to install solar power?

Compared to other European Union countries, Hungary is not yet at the top in terms of installed solar capacity, but has shown considerable growth in recent years. Countries such as Germany, Spain and Italy have significantly larger capacities, but Hungary is rapidly catching up.

How big is Hungary's solar capacity in 2025?

By the second quarter of 2025, Hungary's solar capacity is projected to exceed 8 GW. This remarkable growth is driven by extensive large-scale solar projects and the easing of restrictions on residential solar installations, as reported by the Hungarian Energy and Public Utility Regulatory Authority (MEKH).
