What is a base station power supply?

This acts as the "blood supply" of the base station, ensuring uninterrupted power. It includes: AC distribution box: Distributes mains power and offers surge protection. Switch-mode power supply: Converts and stabilizes power while managing DC output. Battery banks: Serve as backup power to keep systems running during outages. 3.

How do outdoor base stations work?

Outdoor base stations integrate all essential systems into a single Integrated Cabinet, designed to endure harsh conditions like direct sunlight, rain, and extreme temperatures. These units protect the equipment while ensuring efficient functionality. Towers are crucial for mounting antennas at high elevations, ensuring wide signal reach.

What does a base station do?

The base station, positioned between users and data centers, is the first

responder to user requests. It relays signals efficiently, ensuring users stay connected. This image highlights the compact but comprehensive nature of base stations, showcasing their integration of protective enclosures, power systems, and antennas. 3.

What is a radio cabinet?

The cabinet houses critical components like main base station equipment, transmission equipment, power supply systems, and battery banks. Meanwhile, the pole serves as a mounting point for antennas, Remote Radio Units (RRUs), and other equipment, often resembling a “candied hawthorn stick” in its configuration.
