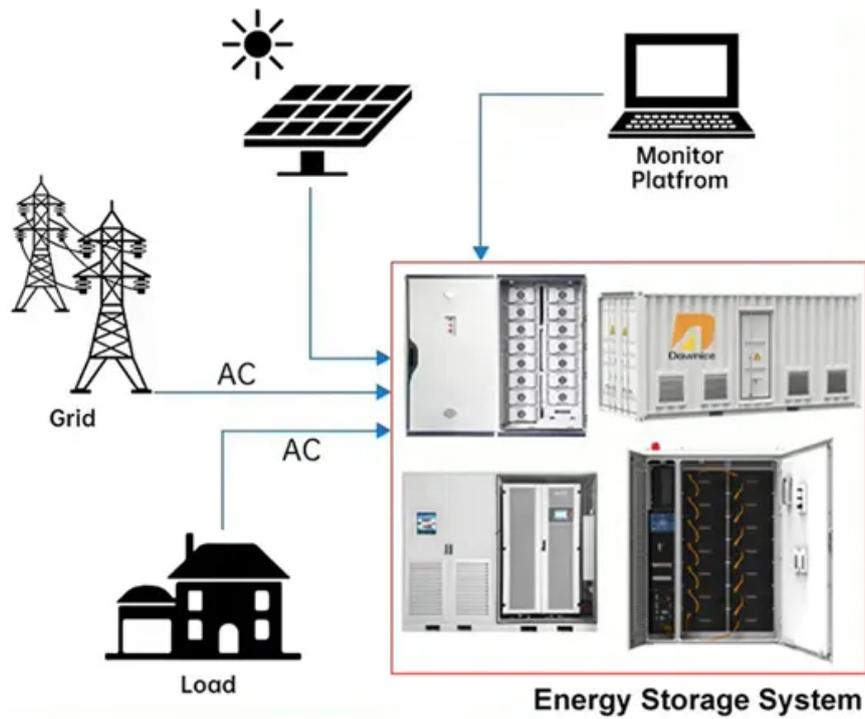

The country aims to achieve a 40% share of renewable energy in total energy consumption by 2030 2. 4,590 MW of new electricity capacity from renewable sources will be supported by the Italian.
