How much CO2 does Kyrgyzstan produce?

higher than the global average. The Kyrgyzstan energy sector contributes to roughly 60%, 9.1 MT of CO2, of its total GHG emissions, where the residential energy consumption and the production of heat & electricity account for over 70.

How many electricity DSOs are there in Kyrgyzstan?

There are four electricity DSOs in Kyrgyzstan and one district heating DSO: Sever Electro serves Bishkek, Talas and the Chuy region, accounting for 42% of distribution. Vostok Electro serves the Issik-Kul and Naryn regions and accounts for 18% of distribution.

Why does Kyrgyzstan support the reinstatement of the exchange?

As regional integration is one of its major energy policy directions, Kyrgyzstan supports the reinstatement of the Kyrgyzstan-Uzbekistan-Tajikistan-Kazakhstan exchange to improve integration and reduce the use of burdensome and inefficient bilateral contracts.

Does Kyrgyzstan use biomass?

Traditional biomass – the burning of charcoal, crop waste, and other organic matter – is not included. This can be an important source in lower-income settings. Kyrgyzstan: How much of the country’s electricity comes from nuclear power?
