Papua New Guinea National Energy Access Transformation Project The Papua New Guinea National Energy Access Transformation Project (NEAT or the 'Project') will be financed by the World Bank and implemented by the National Energy Authority (NEA) and PNG Power Limited (PPL).

Does Papua New Guinea have energy access?

Papua New Guinea (PNG) is the Pacific's largest country with one of the world's lowest rates of energy access (13%). To address this development challenge, Australia, Japan, New Zealand, and the USA joined hands with the PNG government in late 2018 and signed the PNG Electrification Partnership.

Does Papua New Guinea have high energy poverty?

Several pockets of extremely high energy poverty persist throughout the region, most notably in its largest and most populous country, Papua New Guinea (PNG). By recent estimates only 13% of PNG's population is connected to reliable electricity, predominantly in urban areas.

When does the fiscal year of Papua New Guinea end?

The fiscal year (FY) of the Government of Papua New Guinea and its agencies ends on 31 December. FY before a calendar year denotes the year in which the fiscal year ends, e.g., FY2023 ends on 31 December 2023. In this report, "\$" refers to United States dollars unless otherwise stated.
