On average, installing solar panels costs \$18,604 for a 6-kilowatt (kW) system before incentives and tax credits. How much do solar panels cost in New York?

As of 2024, the average cost of solar panels in New York is \$3.30 per watt, making a typical 6.9 kilowatt (kW) solar system \$16,632 after claiming the 30% federal solar tax credit now available. This is higher than the average price of residential solar power systems across the United States, which is currently \$3.00 per watt.

How much does solar cost in California?

Divide annual kWh by ~1,200 (typical kWh/year per kW of solar in much of California). In California, expect \$2.75 – \$3.50 per watt before incentives (solar panel cost in California). How much does a solar system cost in 2025?

Solar panels generate “free” electricity, but installing a system still costs money. A typical American household needs a 10-kilowatt (kW) system to adequately power their home, which costs \$28,241 in 2025. That price effectively drops to \$19,873 after considering the full federal solar tax credit.
