Security of Eritrea s communication base stations



Overview

The station served four key purposes: it was a U.S. Army strategic communications site, an earth terminal for the Defense Satellite Communications System, a Navy communications station, and a high-frequency transmitter for diplomatic communications. Are there ombudspople in Eritrean prisons?

There were no prison ombudspersons to respond to complaints. The government did not grant consular access to detained dual nationals, whom it considers to be only Eritrean. Authorities generally did not permit family visits with persons detained, arrested, or convicted for national security reasons.

Why is Eritrea important to the United States?

Eritrea's importance to the United States was also conditioned in those years by the Clinton administration's hostility to the Islamist government in Sudan, which supported Iraq in the first Gulf war and provided bases to Osama bin Laden in the early 1990s, as well as to Islamist guerrillas threatening Eritrea and other regional states.

Why was Eritrea designated a 'front-line state'?

The United States designated Eritrea, which provided bases for Sudanese opposition groups, as a 'front-line state' in this escalating confrontation. This was further incentive for providing it with military and other aid.

Are Eritrean rebels stirring up trouble around Kagnaw Station?

There are reports of Eritrean rebels causing trouble near Kagnaw Station in Asmara, Ethiopia. I later said goodbye to my army buddies and boarded a Lufthansa flight to Rome, changed planes, and flew Ethiopian Airlines non-stop to Asmara.

Does Eritrea have a relationship with the United States?

Eritrea's relations with the United States have been fraught from the outset. They have been both shaped and overshadowed by those with Ethiopia, and almost always to Eritrea's disadvantage. At first, this was a result of the global projection of American force during and immediately after the Second World War.

Does Eritrea have a human rights organization?

No local human rights nongovernmental organizations operated in the country (see section 2.b., Freedom of Association). The United Nations or Other International Bodies: The government did not permit visits by the UN special rapporteur on human rights in Eritrea and remained opposed to cooperating with his mandate.
