Netherlands-based solar PV manufacturer MCPV has received approval for a €10 million.

2 July 2025, Hanover, Germany - NORD/LB has today announced ca. €110m in financing across separate transactions for the development of three Spanish solar PV farms currently being constructed by Capital Dynamics. The three facilities are located in the Aragón region and will feature over 250,000.

Asturias will host the first large-scale photovoltaic module manufacturing plant in Spain and one of the first plants on an industrial scale in Europe. The initiative, which reinforces the commitment of both companies to the economic reactivation of the mining areas, will promote industrialisation.

Photovoltaic cells have been the building blocks of a solar power boom spurred by Prime Minister Pedro Sánchez, whose support for renewables, combined with Spain's abundant sunshine, has driven a wave of construction. Since he took power in 2018, energy developers have built solar parks, proved.

Plenitude, a subsidiary of the renowned global energy company Eni, has embarked on an ambitious project to construct a 90 MW solar power plant in Spain. This initiative is an integral part of the country's ongoing efforts

towards decarbonization, and it promises to supply clean energy to.

The Spanish Ministry of Ecological Transition (MITECO) has awarded more than €210 million (US\$227.21 million) in funding to seven solar PV manufacturing projects. The provisional results for the RENOVAL programme were released last week by The Institute for Diversification and Energy Saving (IDAE).
