More than 35,000 Uzbeks have received financial support from the state for generating electricity through solar panels, according to the State Tax Committee. Between January and September 2025, 35,284 individuals were granted a total of UZS 153.6bn (\$12.8mn) in subsidies from the state budget for.

Khorezm region remains the leader in total payouts, while Tashkent has dropped from third to fifth place. From January to September 2025, a total of 35,200 households in Uzbekistan received payments under the Solar Home program for selling electricity generated by their solar panels to the national.

The Cabinet of Ministers is establishing the National Energy Efficiency Agency to oversee state policy in the sector. Starting 1 July, the agency will provide subsidies of up to 18.75 million soums (\$1,464) to help residents cover part of the cost of solar panels, water heaters and pumps. President.

In 2025, the state allocates 1000 sums in subsidies for every kWh of energy transferred to the grid from solar panels. But do you know about all the benefits you can get?

Uzbekistan has set an ambitious goal to achieve 20% renewable energy in its energy balance by 2025, demonstrating a strong.

Uzbekistan: Uzbekistan will allocate 2 trillion soums (EUR 148.27 million) in preferential loans to support the installation of solar panels and water heaters on homes and businesses. This initiative mandates the allocation of at least 50% of available rooftop space for solar equipment. Since May.
