South African Republic Lithium Battery Energy Storage System Project



Overview

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Updated 1st July 2025 - The Red Sands Battery Energy Storage System (BESS), set to be Africa’s largest of its kind, has officially reached commercial close. Developed by Globeleq, which is 30% owned by Norfund, in partnership with African Rainbow Energy, the 153 MW/612 MWh project was signed off in.

Friday, 10 November 2023: Eskom unveiled the first of its kind largest Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) project not only in South Africa but in the African continent. Eskom officially opened the Hex BESS site at Worcester in the Western Cape yesterday. The Hex BESS is the first project to be.

A Chinese green technology company has been contracted to supply battery energy storage systems (BESS) for the Oasis 1 cluster of projects in South Africa. Envision Energy announced the contract with the EDF Group, to supply three battery energy storage systems (BESS) amounting to 257MW of capacity.

The project was awarded preferred bidder status in 2024 under the South African government’s Battery Energy Storage Independent Power Producer Procurement Programme, or BESIPPPP. It is the largest standalone BESS plant in Africa to reach commercial close and will involve the construction of a 153.

South Africa has reached a major milestone in its renewable energy transition, as three cutting-edge Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) projects, collectively known as Oasis, progress toward implementation. These projects are part of the nation’s inaugural Battery Energy Storage Independent Power.

South Africa is transitioning toward a low carbon economy. The government has adopted the Integrated Resource Plan 2019 (IRP) and intends to add more than 20,000 MW of wind and solar energy generation capacity, with their share in the country's energy mix growing from the current 3% to 24% by 2030.

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
