South Sudan lithium battery energy storage project



Overview

The 20 MW solar PV plant, located in Juba, the capital city, will have a 14 MWh battery energy storage system & will connect 16,000 households in the world's least electrified country. Does South Sudan have a solar power project?

South Sudan has taken a significant step toward renewable energy with the launch of its first major solar power project. Who distributes electricity in Juba?

The Juba Electricity Distribution Company (JEDCO), a public-private partnership between Ezra Group and SSEC, is responsible for distributing electricity to the public in Juba. JEDCO receives bulk energy from Ezra Construction & Development Group and distributes it across the region.
