The largest solar energy storage project in Mauritius



Overview

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On July 14, 2025, Mr. Mahen Kundasamy, CEO of the Economic Development Board (EDB) of Mauritius, held a follow-up meeting with Mr. Olivier Gaering, Regional Director Indian Ocean of Qair Mauritius. As a leading independent power producer specialising in renewable energy, Qair has been a key player.

Paris, August 7, 2025 – Independent renewable energy company Qair announces the closing of a new loan to support the implementation of a hybrid solar photovoltaic and battery energy storage system (BESS) project in Mauritius. This project builds upon Qair's long-standing presence in the Indian.

The four projects in the Stor'Sun initiative that Qair won in 2024 are now funded, and will aim to provide a consistent 12-hour energy output. Renewable energy developer Qair has secured financing from SBM Bank (Mauritius) Ltd for its Stor'Sun I and II hybrid solar-plus-storage projects. These two.

In an exciting development for renewable energy in Africa, Qair, an Independent Power Producer (IPP), has successfully closed a loan to finance a significant 60MW hybrid solar photovoltaic and battery energy storage system (BESS) project in Mauritius. This initiative is poised to play a crucial.

Mauritius is accelerating its clean energy transition by opening a tender for solar projects with a combined capacity of 80 MW, including integrated battery storage systems. This initiative represents the country's first major solar tender since 2020 and signals a renewed push towards its ambitious.
