Why do solar panels use batteries?

Not all photovoltaic installations have batteries. Sometimes, it is preferable to supply all the electrical energy generated by the solar panels to the electrical network.

What are the advantages of solar batteries?

Let's begin with the advantages brought by solar batteries: Storing excess electricity: whenever the solar panel produces an excess of electricity - during a bright, sunny morning, for example - your battery can store this excess to be used at night.

Why do people use solar panels for electricity generation?
