Total investment in the 1300MWH energy storage project



Overview

Will battery energy storage investment hit a record high in 2023?

After solid growth in 2022, battery energy storage investment is expected to hit another record high and exceed USD 35 billion in 2023, based on the existing pipeline of projects and new capacity targets set by governments.

What is the largest European battery-based energy storage project?

In May 2023, we launched our largest European battery-based energy storage project at the Antwerp platform in Belgium. With its 40 containers, the site will develop a capacity of 75 MWh, which is equivalent to the daily consumption of almost 10,000 homes.

How much money is invested in battery energy storage in 2022?

Global investment in battery energy storage exceeded USD 20 billion in 2022, predominantly in grid-scale deployment, which represented more than 65% of total spending in 2022.

How many battery storage projects will Saft have in 2025?

In March 2025 we announced five new battery storage projects with a total capacity of 221 MWh in the following cities: These projects, piloted by Kyon Energy – acquired by TotalEnergies in February 2024 – will benefit from Saft's latest-generation electricity storage technology (iShift LFP / lithium-iron-phosphate containers).

How much battery storage capacity does totalenergies have in France?

In February 2020, TotalEnergies was awarded 129 megawatts (MW) of battery-based storage capacity in France as part of a call for tenders issued by the French Electricity Transmission System Operator (RTE).

How many GW of battery storage is there in 2022?

Total installed grid-scale battery storage capacity stood at close to 28 GW at the end of 2022, most of which was added over the course of the previous 6 years. Compared with 2021, installations rose by more than 75% in 2022, as around 11 GW of storage capacity was added.
