If that's the case, you only need a Taiwan power plug adapter. Be cautious with appliances like hair dryers, curling irons, or kettles, which are often single-voltage (e.g., 220-240V).

What voltage does Taiwan use?

Taiwan uses the same voltage as the United States, 110-120 volts. However, the plug types are different. You will need a plug adapter for Taiwan, but not a voltage converter or transformer. If your electronics are dual voltage, you can use them in Taiwan without any modifications.

Do I need a travel adapter or transformer when traveling to Taiwan?

Yes! North Americans do not need a travel adapter or transformer when traveling to Taiwan. Most device plugs will work with the outlet types in Taiwan. Also, the voltage in Taiwan is the same as in North America. Please note: an adapter will be needed if your device plug has a grounding pin and you are trying to use a Type A outlet.

Do I need a travel adapter in Taipei?
