The voltage in Bolivia is 230 volts and the frequency is 50 Hz. Since Bolivia mixes two kinds of plugs and sockets, most outlets are hybrids that work with both. There are two types of universal sockets: the ungrounded version (which accepts types A and C) and.

In Bolivia, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type A and type C are used. The standard voltage is 115 / 230 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Bolivia is a country in South America with.

Most of Bolivia uses 220-230 volt outlets so you can use electrical/electronic devices brought from home if the standard voltage in your country is between 220V and 240V. Be aware that some older buildings in La Paz still use 110 volt

In Bolivia, there are two main types of power plugs and outlets: Type A and Type C. Both types are used in airports, hotels, restaurants, etc., but they differ in terms of shape. Type A: Type A plugs have two flat prongs on either side of the plug. Mostly used in the United States, Canada, Mexico.

Do device plugs work in Bolivia?

North Americans device plugs may not work with all outlet types in Bolivia. Also, a transformer is required as the voltage in Bolivia may be different from Europe. Please note: an adapter will be needed if your device plug has a grounding pin and you are trying to use a Type A outlet.
