# Which outdoor power supply is best in Spain



## Overview

---

Spain uses a 230-volt electrical system, while the United States uses 120 volts. If your device is designed for 120 volts, you will need a voltage converter or transformer to use it in Spain. Do I need a power adapter in Spain?

Since electrical sockets in Spain require two round pins, you'll definitely need an adapter if you're American and have American devices. A US-to-Spain power adapter will allow you to plug in devices with the North American-style flat prongs (Type A and B plugs).

What are the different types of power plugs in Spain?

In Spain, there are two main types of power plugs and outlets: Type C and Type F. Type C: Type C plugs have two round prongs on either side of the plug, commonly known as Euro plugs. Mostly used in Europe, South America, and Africa. Type C outlets can be fit with either Type E or Type F plugs.

What type of power sockets are used in Spain?

That's right, amigos! In Spain, the walls are adorned with Type F and Type C power sockets, also lovingly referred to as 'Schuko' and 'Euro' plugs. But here's the twist in our travel tale. The 'Euro' plug (Type C) has two round pins, while the super 'Schuko' (Type F) comes with two round pins and two earth clips at the side.

What type of electrical outlet does Spain use?

Spain primarily uses Type C and Type F electrical outlets. These types are common in many European countries. Also known as the standard "Euro" plug, Type C outlets have two round pins. Also known as "Schuko," Type F outlets have two round pins with two earth clips on the side. The standard voltage in Spain is 230V, and the frequency is 50Hz.

What type of plug does Spain use?

Spain uses plug type F, which features two round pins with two earth clips on the side. This is the standard European plug type and is widely used throughout the country. It is important to note that while type C plugs (two round pins) can also be used in Spain, they lack the earth connection and are not recommended for safety reasons.

What kind of electricity does Spain use?

Before we launch into our culinary and cultural adventure, there's one teeny-tiny detail many travelers often overlook - the electricity! Let us not forget: Spain, like many other European countries, uses Type F and Type C plugs with a standard voltage of 230 V and a frequency of 50 Hz.
